**After the briefing, racing starts,** please listen to tannoy messages for your team name before approaching the pontoon and donning lifejackets. We have coracles with team colours to match the bibs. Please check the race card to find out your team colour.

- Safety boats will be on site to deal with any medical emergencies. We will also have fully qualified lifeguards and will provide life jackets for all participants.
- Please take extra care when near the river and do not enter the pontoon without a lifejacket.
- Please be considerate of people walking on the towpath.
- All team members must be able to swim at least 200 metres fully clothed.
- Please ensure you wash your hands after being on the water.
